André Masson, who accepted Taittinger's invitation to turn a champagne bottle into a work of art, is a master of the surrealist movement. He chose to style his bottle as an "ode to joy" in honor of the wine of Champagne. André Masson died on October 28, 1987 in Paris.

Manfred's 2013 Grenache Female checks in as a blend of $78 \%$ Grenache, $19 \%$ Syrah and 3\% Mourvèdre that is mostly from his Eleven Confessions estate vineyard in Sta. Rita Hills, yet has smaller portions from his Cumulus, The Third Twin and Bien Nacido vineyards. Seeing just over 24 months in a mix of demimuids, 300-liter Hog Heads and barrique, it has a sensational bouquet of spring flowers, black raspberries, black cherries, violets, licorice and camphor. Reminding me of a great vintage of Raymond Usseglio's Cuvée Imperiale, this full-bodied, elegant Grenache is impeccably balanced, has a full and layered mid-palate (which is missing from just about every other Grenache made in California), and sweet tannin on the finish.

It will cruise for over two decades.

## SILENT AUCTION RULES

1. Items will be auctioned through the silent auction on the evening of November 14, 2023, at the Consulate General of France in New York City. Bidding will begin at 6:00 PM and end at 8:00 PM.
2. Bidding will be accepted in person on the designated form by signature and price.
3. All signed bids and sales are final. No refunds or exchanges on auction items are permitted. All items have been donated to FAAFC and are sold by FAAFC and not the Donor.
4. FAAFC warrants neither the quality nor the value of items auctioned. Descriptions of items have been made with every reasonable effort to be accurate, but all items are sold "as is" without warranty or representation of any kind to the correctness of the description, genuineness, authenticity, condition, or quality of fitness for any purpose.
5. FAAFC is a 501(c)3 organization. The amount paid by the successful bidder that may be deductible for U.S. tax purposes is limited to the excess of the amount over the fair market value of the item or package, subject to any limitation that might otherwise apply. The fair market value is determined by the Donor and is displayed on each lot item or package. The minimum bid which is also displayed is below the fair market value of the lot and incremental bids are stated for each lot.
6. Payment for auction items must be made in full by credit card, electronic fund transfer, check, or cash on the night of the auction or, if the winning bidder is not present at the end of the auction, by phone on November 15, 2023. No item or package will be sold for less than the minimum bid.
7. The highest bidder for any item becomes the purchaser. Winning bidders, if not present to purchase their items on the evening of the auction, will be notified the next day, November 15, 2023.
